

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER

Monitoring Requirements Not Met for [Cahokia]

Our water system violated several drinking water standards over the past year. Even though these were not emergencies, as our customers, you have a right to know what happened and what we did to correct these situations.

We are required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not our drinking water meets health standards. During [5/1/16 – 5/31/16] we ["did not complete all monitoring or testing"] for total coliform/chloramine and therefore cannot be sure of the quality of our drinking water during that time.

What should I do?

There is nothing you need to do at this time.

The table below lists the contaminant(s) we did not properly test for during the last year, how often we are supposed to sample for total coliform/chloramine and how many samples we are supposed to take, how many samples we took, when samples should have been taken, and the date on which follow-up samples were (or will be) taken.

Contaminant	Required sampling frequency	Number of samples taken	When all samples should have been taken	When samples were or will be taken
Chloramine	5	4	5/1/16 – 5/31/16	6/1/16 – 6/30/16
Coliform	5	4	5/1/16 – 5/31/16	6/1/16 – 6/30/16

What happened? What is being done?

We have since taken the required samples, as described in the last column of the table above. The result(s) showed we are meeting drinking water standards.
